- Teacher Requests:
 - Ms. Borelli: This year the school board is doing Winter on Wheels. This included skis for the kids, and it was a huge success. This school year PE has been completely outside for grades 3-6. Would like to continue this going forward. We would like to purchase some skis and snowshoes for our school to have this every year. One class set for skiing would be around \$7,250, it includes 38 sets of boots, poles, and skis. For two sets it would be just under \$13,000. The cost for a set snowshoes is around \$1,300 or \$2,530 for two sets. Motion by Athanasia to allocate \$9,625.69 to purchase 1 set of skis and 1 set of snowshoes. Seconded by Sherry.

- Mme Rennie: Would like to purchase 4 sets of earphones to replace some of the ones in the listening center. Best price is through scholastic at \$19.99. Would like to replace some of the books in the grade 1 classes. For 56 books the cost is around \$470 plus tax and shipping, or for 58 books \$495 plus tax and shipping. Currently we have about \$1,000 in scholastic credit. Motion by Athanasia to allocate \$666.86 plus \$50 for shipping to purchase new earphones and books. *if the shipping exceeds \$50, we will need to reapprove the cost for shipping. We will try to use scholastic credit first. Seconded by Sherry.
