

## THINGS YOU CAN DO TO PREPARE YOUR CHILD:


VISIT THE SCHOOL'S **DAYCARE** TOGETHER.

PLAY WITH **WORDS, SOUNDS, NUMBERS** AND **LETTERS**.




ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO **SHARE** HIS OR HER TOYS. GET YOUR CHILD TO
