

## Role of the school nurse:

As the school nurse, I am employed by the CLSC and am in charge of numerous schools. My role is to ensure the safety of your child while at school. I take charge of the students who have allergies and require an epipen, of those who have health problems and/or chronic problems which require interventions, or simply to make all staff aware. I meet with parents if needed.

I am a liaison between the parents and the school. If your child develops an infectious disease like chickenpox, you are to advise the school and they contact me.

I do health promotion/prevention for the students: puberty classes in grade 5, hygiene care, intimidation, organize and prepare for the grade 4 vaccines.

We offer catch-up vaccination clinics at the Vaudreuil CLSC starting in kindergarten. To make apt. please call 450-455-6171 ext 70142

Remember before your child starts kindergarten to please have your child see an optometrist (it's free until 18 yrs old), the dentist and make sure their vaccinations are up to date (4-6yrs old vaccines 450-455-6171 ext.70113).
