For the first action we had several first nation presenters come to our school to work with grade 3, 4 and 5. As well for the whole school, we had African drumming and dancing, first nations dancing and storytelling. 2 classes had the opportunity to try virtual glasses that took them through how a person with Autism navigates their world. This initiative prompted a student with autism to tell his classmates that he had autism. The parents were very moved by the fact that this activity gave their son the courage to open up and share.

Next year we will again invite presenters to share their culture, stories and experiences with our students.
