

FRENCH IMMERSION:

The language of instruction from Kindergarten to the end of Cycle 1 is 80% French; this includes Math. In Cycle 2 & 3 the language of instruction is approximately 50% English and 50% French. The language of instruction for Math is English in Cycle 2 & 3.

MUSIC AND THE ARTS:

Every student is taught by a specialist in music, drama and visual arts. Students perform in music and drama twice a year in a staged production. Students can participate in the school choir. Our music room has a wide array of musical instruments used for instruction. Student artwork is displayed around the school, on our website and in an annual Art Exhibit.

SPACIOUS PLAYGROUND:

Our playground is large enough to have separate play areas for children of each age group. Each of these areas has its own playground equipment appropriate to the age group. The games painted on the pavement and a variety of other games; together with our large green space, ensure that children have every opportunity for positive interactive physical activity.

TECHNOLOGY:

We use computer technology in every classroom with high-speed fiber-optic and Wi-Fi secured internet service. Our staff is committed to the Digital Citizen Project of the Lester B Pearson School Board. Many of our classrooms are equipped with INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARDS. Students have access to a computer lab where many of our students interact with Media Arts software to produce multi-media projects.



DAYCARE AND LUNCH SERVICES:

Our Ministry of Education Daycare services are available from 7:00am, during the lunch hour, and after school until 6:00pm. Daycare provides homework supervision and educational activities. We offer hot lunches as well as pizza and submarine sandwiches. All of these services are offered at an additional cost to parents.

PLAYGROUND PALS:

Cycle 3 students are trained as Playground Pals. They are assigned to the play areas of younger students where they provide positive role modeling, ensure students are engaged in positive-fair play, and they alert the adults on supervision to significant events. Our Peer Mediators practice problem-solving techniques with students who are involved in minor conflicts. We have a designated area for Conflict Resolution in the playground.

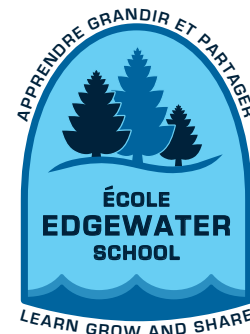
