<i>Official Communications</i>	
<b>Interim 1 Report</b>	On October 12th, the interim report will be sent home as a hard copy, which will include comments on your child's learning and behavior.
<b>Term 1 Report Card</b>	The Term 1 Report Card will be issued through Mozaik November 20 <sup>th</sup> , and this will count for 20% of the final mark for the year.
<b>Term 2 Report Card</b>	The term 2 Report Card will be available through Mozaik March 15 <sup>th</sup> and will count for 20% of the final mark.
<b>Term 3 Report Card</b>	The Term 3 Report Card will be issued through Mozaik June 21 <sup>st</sup> and will count for 60% of the final mark for the year.

<b>Report Card: How Results Are Determined</b>

<p><b>For Terms 1, 2, and 3</b> the teacher enters a percentage mark that reflects the knowledge and competencies that a student has acquired - based on the evaluations carried out during the term (tests, assignments, etc.) and where applicable for the year, including any compulsory Board or Ministry exams.</p> <p>In the case of English Language Arts, Mathematics and French, Second Language, a <b>Subject Mark</b> is calculated based on the weightings assigned to the subject-specific competencies established by MEES (<i>see subject table on the first page</i>).</p> <p>MEES = Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur</p>		<p><b>The 3rd term includes a Final Mark.</b></p> <p>It is calculated using the results of the three weighted terms (20%,20% 60%) and the MEES exam results (if applicable).</p> <p>*The MEES exam counts for 10% of the Final Mark.</p> <p>*Only applies in Gr. 6 English Language Arts and Mathematics.</p>
